PROCLAMATION SUSPENDING BURNING PERMITS ***MODIFICATION***

In the Southern Region of CAL FIRE
Including all State Responsibility Areas within the following counties:

Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, Calaveras, Fresno, Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Mono, Monterey, Santa Barbara, San Benito, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Tulare and Tuolumne

Burning, as described below, is permitted in the following counties: San Luis Obispo, Ventura and San Diego

Due to the menace of wildfires and their potential to destroy life and property, current and predicted fire weather and other factors, and utilizing the authority vested in me by Section 4423.1 of the Public Resources Code, I hereby proclaim:

- **ALL RESIDENTIAL "DOORYARD" (FORM LE-62) BURNING PERMITS** within State Responsibility Areas in the counties listed above will be **SUSPENDED** beginning 08:00 hours September 18, 2008.
- Agricultural, forest management, hazard abatement and other industrial-type burning is suspended
- Campfires within organized campgrounds or on private property are allowed if the campfire is maintained in such a manner as to prevent the campfire from spreading to the wildland vegetation.

This suspension will continue in place until formally cancelled by me.

This PROCLAMATION is issued at Fresno, California, this 18th day of September 2008.
